Doolan who did intermarry with Susan Whitted widow of Hiram Whitted deceased doth hereby Relinquish unto Samuel Mobley all my right and claim to all the ballance that is or might be due to Hiram Whitted deceased or the portion of Elizabeth Mobley as above mentioned and also to all the claim that I have against Samuel Mobley for a Negro Woman by the name of Fanny and her increase that she has had or may have to him and his heirs for ever also I do hereby forever quit claim to all Transactions or any power of attorney made by Samuel Mobley to Hiram Whitted deceased or any claim whatsoever which this is to be considered a full settlement of all debts dues notes bonds or controversies of any kind whatsoever up to this date which the said Samuel Mobley has had or may have against Hiram Whitted deceased, as witness hereunto I do set my hand and affix my seal this 18th day of February A.D. 1830.
