



State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I John Pitman of the State of North Carolina and Berk. County of the one part and George Linza of State of South Carolina and Greenville District of the other part witnesseth that for an in consideration of the sum ten dollars to him paid I have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George Linza all and singularly that tract of land lying and being in Greenville District and State of South Carolina on the branches of N. Saluda and South pæclett begining on a Spanish oak running S. 3 E. 20 to Chesnut thence S. 63 W. 15 to a white oak thence S. 3 N. 20-50 to hickory thence along a conditional line to Morris Goswills line thence to the begining containing one hundred and fifty acus more or less together with all and singular the wrights members hereditaments and appertinances to the S. premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Linza his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the S. premises unto the S. George Linza his heirs and assigns against my self and my and my heirs and against all and Every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I the S. John Pitman have hereunto set my hand and affixt my seal this 23rd day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen signed, sealed and delivered in presence of us. November the 23rd 1819.
