concluded I have been so advised that a quable to the tittle generally  
Executed by Col. Alston to me. that, that Lot was conveyed with  
the other property & that therefore the tittle was now vested in  
me. It having been in that situation for a number of years &  
nothing like a legal or equitable claim appearing, I have deter-  
-mined that the Lot may be exposed to public sale by the  
Town Commissioners of Greenville at such credits & on such terms  
as they may conclude on, & that the money arising from the sale of  
said Lot shall be appropriated to the Building of a Market House  
in said Village, and will & do hereby promise to Execute a quit  
Claim from myself & my heirs to the said Lot of Land at any suitable  
time, after the sale of said Lot. Given under my hand & seal at
