 a part of a Tract of land granted to D. Yeargin the land to be conveyed
 begins at a Saunder's corner thence to a post oak corner on J.W.
 Bramblett's Land as was, and thence with A.H. Parkins line to a pine
 N. 6° W. 7^{ch} 50 rods to a Stake thence 15 Chs to a post oak bush thence to a
 Red oak on A.H. Parkins line thence down the meander of said branch
 to a Stake thence on Yeargin's line to a Stake thence up said branch to
 the beginning corner containing 100. acres more or less together with all
