This Indenture, made the first day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty between William Chace Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville district at Greenville Court House in the said State of the one part and John Hodges of Greenville District of the other part. Whereas Alexander Mathis and Alpha his wife, Alfred Merritt and Ezekiel Merritt Heirs of Wheaton Merritt deceased on or about the Eleventh day of May A.D. 1829. did Exhibit their Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against Sarah ²²⁴ Merritt, widow, Melinda Merritt Ezekiel J. Salaman and Narcissa his wife William H. Talley and Elizabeth N. his wife, Irina J. Merritt, Almira B. Merritt and Hiram W. Merritt heirs at law.
