empowered for the purpose, by deed under our hands and seals reque-  
stably Executed, bearing date the Nineteenth day of August in the year  
of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty, and certified  
under the hand and seal of John G. North Notary Public the  
same day, for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to  
us in hand paid by John Watson Esqr of Greenville District in the said State  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have Granted bargained sold  
and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto  
the said John Watson all that plantation or tract of Land situate lying  
and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on Saluda River  
or Containing three hundred and twenty eight acres more or less begin-  
ning at a white oak corner on Saluda River and running thence  
N. 27° E. 64.50 chains to a Stake corner, and thence N. 70. W. 48.50 chains  
to a willow stump or rock on the bank of the said River and  
thence down the meander of the said River to the beginning being  
the same tract of land which Dr. John Robinson sold and conveyed  
to Joseph P. LaBruce now deceased by deed dated the nineteenth day  
of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
twenty four and which we convey under and by virtue of an order  
or decree of the Court of Chancery made at its Winter sitting for  
Georgetown District in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and twenty eight as by reference to the records of the said  
Court will fully appear together with all and singular the rights, number, Hudi-  
-aments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise in-  
-cident or appertaining; To Have and to Hold all and singular the pre-  
-mises before mentioned unto the said John Watson his heirs and
