 Greenville District } Mcjunkin of Greenville District in the State of
 South Carolina in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to me paid by Jeremiah
 Cleveland of the District and State aforesaid Have granted, bargained, sold and
 released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said
 Jeremiah Cleveland all that part or tract of Land Lying on the Middle Fork
 of Saluda River Containing two acres more or less being part of a tract of
 land Originally granted to my Father Daniel Mcjunkin Beginning on a birch
 on the East Bank of the River opposite the Land Caesepid by Daniel and
 George Mcjunkin to Jeremiah Cleveland and running thence a north
 Eastwardly direction to a Stake on the East Bank of the River a least seven
 Chains thence down the River as it meanders to the Beginning Birch corner
 Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments, and appurten-
 ances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
 ing to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland, his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my
 self, heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant, and forever defend, all and singular the
 said premises, unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland, his heirs and assigns, against myself and
 against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part
 thereof. Witness my hand and seal this twenty third day of February in the year of our Lord
 One thousand eight hundred and thirty one and in the fifty fifth year of the Independence
