Bradlove of the state and district aforesaid HAVE Granted bargained sold and released and do by these presents grant bargain sell and release unto the said John W. Bradlove a certain parcel or tract of land lying in the District and State aforesaid on the waters or branches of Morgans Creek beginning on a red Oak bush a corner between William Butler and John Mason running thence E. 37 ch to a Chestnut a corner of the Land wherein Willie Orr Johnson now lies thence S. 65 E. 6 ch 50 lrs to a post oak old corner thence N. 21 W. 34 ch 25 lrs to a post oak near Goodjons corner 3x thence N. 5 W. 5 ch 40 lrs to a Chestnut 3x between William Butler & the said Land thence S. 55 W. 23 ch to a red oak by a road thence S. 24 W. 20 ch to the beginning supposed to contain Eighty four Acres be the same more or less it being part of a Survey originally granted to Robert Goodjone which land was conveyed to David Barnett to Eliza Hannen from Eliza Hannen unto Jacob Land and from the said Land unto the said Eliza Hannen and from the said Eliza Hannen unto John W.
