S 12 chs to a P. o. thence W 27 25 to a Stake thence N 12 to a P. o. thence E to the Beginning together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances that unto belonging to have & to hold all & singular the before mentioned premises unto the sd Randolph his heirs & assigns & I do bind my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant & for ever defend the above mentioned premises unto the sd Randolph his heirs and assigns for ever from the claims of all persons lawfully claiming the same or any parts thereof in witness where of I have here unto set my hand & seal this 29th Nov: 1838 in the presence of John McDade & John Naughton

Know all men by these presents that I Spartan Goodlett of the District of Greenville & State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Edward Croft of the District & State aforesaid have granted bargain sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Edward Croft all that tract or parcel of land situate lying in said District on the waters of Richland Creek waters of Reedy River whereon I now live containing one hundred and twenty eight acres more or less being parts of a tract of land originally granted to Alexander Greer and belonging to the Estate of Forest Hudson deceased and the parts drawn by Elizabeth Hudson one of the heirs of the said Deceased as will appear by the plat of the same made and returned in to the Clerks office in said District by the Commissioners appointed
