 whereas by virtue of sundry writs of *Fieri Facias* issued out of the Court of  
 Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville tenth the 25th day  
 of April in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and  
 Twenty Eight at the suit of, of Daniel Welsh and others to me directed
