

The sum of Two thousand Dollars paid to me by James C. Harrison of said State and District have Bargained sold and to lease and by these presents do bargain sell and release unto the said James C. Harrison his heirs and assigns a tract or parcel of lands in said District where our Manor lies on waters of Raybans Creek containing three Hundred and Twenty Acres but this same manor has being the Land conveyed to me by John Alexander on the 23rd of August 1828 as by Reference to his Acct. of that date will more fully appear also sixty five Acres with the Saw mill there on and twenty five Acres from William Cox also a small piece from Thomas Harrison being in the whole Three Hundred and Twenty Acres more or less and all the Lands Taxed in said District a plot of which except two small pieces bought from himself and Thomas Harrison is herewith given to him made on a Resurvey by John W. Harrison Esq. to and to hold all and singular the premises described to the said James C. Harrison his heirs and assigns forever together with all the rights members Accidents and appurtenances to them belonging or in anywise Incident or appertaining and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &c. to warrant and forever defend the same to him and his. Against myself and mine and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof In Witness to which I have hereunto set my hand and Affixed my seal this 10th day of August 1835
