 down the branch to a poplar thence across Said branch over
 an other branch to a gum thence down Said branch or Creek
 to the beginning corner together with all and singular the
 rights, members, benefits and appurtenances unto the Said
 Chaloma May and her heirs for ever and I do hereby bind
 myself my heirs &c to warrant & for ever defend the above dis-
 cussed Land for the use and purpose before mentioned in
 the Said Chaloma May from me and my heirs and every other
 person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the Same or
 any part thereof as witness my hand and Seal this 11 day of
 January A.D. 1836 Signed Sealed and acknowledged in presence
