and state aforesaid I have granted bargained sold and delivered
and by these presents do grant bargaine sell and release unto
the said Charles Livingston a plantation or tract of Land
estimated at one thousand acres or the same more or less
situate lying and being in the district and state aforesaid
being part of a tract of Land originally granted to Nath
aniel Walker lying on both sides of Little Rock Creek and the muddy
Branch waters of Eno River Beginning on a white O3X standing in the edge
of a small pond where Bayles Smiths land comes ther running on
Bayles Smiths line N43E back to a R. O. 3X thence on said Bayles Smiths
Smiths line to a black jack st adjoining to Issac D Smiths land the
ce on Issac D Smiths line across Little Rock Creek onto a Black Jack st where
it adjoins with Bayles Smiths land running thence on said Bayles Smiths
line a crop said Little Rock Creek running S16E48 to a Dogwood 3X thence
on Land Sheppards to the beginning white O3X together with all and
singular rights and privileges appurtenant to the said premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
the said premises unto the said Charles Livingston his heirs and
successors and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
administrators to warrant and defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Charles Livingston his heirs and success
ors against myself my heirs and against every other person whom
soever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof within
my hands and to seal this 13 day of Sept in the year of our Lord one thousand
two hundred and thirty six and in sixty first year of the
Independence of the United States of America I sign and seal
in presence of Elliott L Smith 3 *Benjamin Smith*
