Greenville District War Butler of the State and district in
aforesaid consideration of one hundred
Dollars to me in hand paid by Jonathan Ward of the State and dis-
trict aforesaid have granted Bargained sold and released and by these
present do bargain grant sell and release unto the said Jonathan
Ward all that parcel or tract of Land containing three hundred
acres more or less situate in Greenville District on Branches of Smith's
Pacolt River bounded at the time of Survey North Eastward by the
David Headstone lands south Eastward by Samuel Eastby and
Southward by James Brazile & westward near the hog Back moun-
tain by lands unknown and northward by land granted to Danca-
n Campbell being a tract surveyed in April 1794 for John Headstone given
to me the second day of September 1799 to James P. Guinane and his
heirs and afterwards conveyed by said last wife to James P. Guinane
Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and app-
panances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or
pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Jonathan Ward his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to
warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said Jonathan Ward his heirs and assigns against myself and my
Heirs and all persons claiming under myself and his heirs lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand
and seal this the eighth day of Oct in the year of our Lord one thousand
said eight hundred and thirty six made in the sixth first year
of the Independence of the United States of America signed
sealed and delivered in presence of Wm Beattie
