 which its appurtenances unto the said Ezekiel J. Salmons his heirs and assigns
 forever as fully and absolutely as I the said James M. Daniel might collect or ought
 to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and that
 the said Writs of Fieri Facias or otherwise
