being a part of a tract originally granted to James Wofford on the 4th day of May
- 1772 Beginning on a Chestnut stump runs N 32.50 to a black oak 3x 7 inches
S 18 E to a pine 4x 3 inches N 82.75 to a stake then N 70 E 11.40 to a maple 3x 3 1/2
to Red oak 3x 7 inches S 13 E 50 to Poplar 124 W 3 to o. 3x 7 inches N 68 W 39 to the

incidents hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and sing
ular the premises before mentioned unto the said A. B. King and do
hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend unto the said A. B. King his heirs and assigns forever
against myself and my heirs and against every other person claiming
or to claim lawfully the same or any part thereof in witness whereof
