examined by me, did declare, that she does freely, voluntarily, and with  
out any Compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever,  
providence, release, and forever relinquish unto the within named Thomas  
Springfield his Heirs and Assigns, all his interest and estate, and also  
all his right and claim of DOWER, of, in, or to all and singular the  
premises within mentioned and release. Given under my hand & seal  
this thirty first day of July Anno Domini 1837. *Eliza Geddy*
