Know all men by
 these presents that I William Richards of Greenville District and State
 aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred Dollars
 to me in hand paid by Barnett Smith of the district of Laurens and State
 aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
 do grant bargain and sell unto the said Barnett Smith a plantation
 or tract of land lying and being on the waters of Reddy River and
 Ennoree River containing three hundred and seventy four acres more
 or less it being two lots originally granted to James Seabourn and
 conveyed down through different hands to the said William Richan
 beginning on a spanish oak 3 x running N 43. W 35. chains 50 links
 to a pine thence S 57 1/2 W 57. 60 chains to a post oak 3 x S 39. E 36.
 14 chains S 40. E 15 chains to a stake, thence S. 81. E. 47. 77 chains to
 a stake 3 x thence N 13 1/2, W 44. chains 25 links to the beginning
 spanish oak corner, which includes the land to be conveyed
