 To Greenville District, that I, William Jones for and in  
 Rhoda Stone, consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars to me  
 in hand paid by Rhoda Stone of the State and District aforesaid, have granted  
 bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release  
 unto the said Rhoda Stone all that plantation or tract of Land containing two  
 hundred and twenty two acres (more or less) Situate in the State and District  
 aforesaid lying on the waters of Horse Creek, Beginning on a Stone 3x and running  
 thence S. 52 E. 5.79 to a White Oak 3x thence S. 22 W. 16.25 to a Stake 3x thence  
 S. 60 E. 33.20 to a Stake 3x thence S. 61 E. 40.50 to a Squared 3x thence E. 22 N.  
 W. 46.40 to a Stake 3x thence N. 48 W. 12.40 to a poplar 3x at the spring thence  
 down the spring branch about 19 chains to a persimmon 3x thence S. 72 W. 19.50 to a  
 Stake 3x thence S. 32 W. about 15 chains to the beginning corner Bounded on all  
 sides by Joseph McCulloughs land, Together with all and singular the rights  
 members, Inclosures and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise in-  
 cident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises  
 before mentioned unto the said Rhoda Stone her heirs and assigns forever.  
 And I do truly bind myself my heirs, executors, and administrators to warrant  
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Rhoda Stone  
 her heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person  
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness
