 Taylor all that tract or parcel of Land situated in the District of Greenville
 and State aforesaid for the consideration or sum of Five hundred and twenty
 three dollars to me in Hand paid by the said Thomas Taylor which payment
 I acknowledge to be well and truly paid. This tract or parcel of Land
 is lying on the North Side of Enoree River on the waters of Sick Creek
 Beginning on a Black Gum corner, joining Lands of the widow Crowder
 and Ethel Holtzclaw, thence running North 55° W. 50 chains to a Stake corner
 joining Lands of Peter Cauley. thence N. 35° E. to a pine corner joining lands
 of Harper and Edward Bridwell thence with said Bridwell's line to a
 Post Oak corner, thence with said Bridwell's line to a White Oak corner
 on the bank of Sick Creek joining Calon Carney. thence down the meander
 of said Creek to the widow Crowder's line, thence with said line to the Beginning
 corner, containing two hundred acres more or less. Together with all and
 singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
