In Witness I set my hand and Seal in presence of

D. 1843.

Green have this day agreed to pay to Seveland and Blasingame the sum of thirty seven dollars & 50<sup>cts</sup> for Rent for the place where Seveland live, including the place where Green live, and I am to give them peaceable possession of all the Lands I have this day conveyed unless they agree to rent me the same next year, or I do will and truly pay unto the said Seveland & Blasingame the sum of three hundred and thirty seven dollars & 50<sup>cts</sup> by the first day of Aug next, then in case I fail to pay the money as aforesaid. I am quietly to give them possession of all the lands aforesaid.

We agree & bind ourselves that in case Green pays us the above amount of three hundred and thirty seven & 50<sup>cts</sup> (\$ 337.50) by the first day of Aug next we are to make or refund back to him his title of the Lands 6<sup>th</sup> July 1842.
