 Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I, Wilson Barton for the consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by James McKinney have bargained sold and by these presents do bargain sell and relinquish unto the said James McKinney a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid State, & District of Greenville and in Barton's Fork of Tyger River, bounded by lands belonging to Thomas Barton, James Goodlett, Wilson Goodlett, and Sarah McKinney, two hundred acres, more or less beginning on a pine corner, on the bank of Wilson Goodlett's ditch, running thence N. 46. E. 37. C. to a B. O. thence W. E. 54. Chs 57. links to an ash thence 46. W. 37 Chs to a Stake, thence N. 44 W. 54. Chs. 57. links to the beginning corner, which Land, I do warrant & defend unto the said James McKinney, his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs and assigns present or any person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 4th day of July 1840, Signed, Sealed & delivered in the presence of
