 This Indenture made the twenty fifth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred forty, between George F. Jones Esqⁿ Commissioner of the honorable court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville C. S. in the said State of the one part and Susan McCoy of the other part, whereas the said Susan McCoy on or about the 5th day of May 1840, did exhibit her bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville C. S. in the said State, against Robt Cox, M. McCoy, C. C. McCoy & C. J. McCoy stating that she the said Complainant had paid the sum of fifteen hundred Dollars, one half the price of a tract of Land lying on the North Fork of Saluda River in Greenville dist^t State aforesaid, which tract was purchased by the said Robt Cox and J. H. W. McCoy of Mr. M. McCanall with the understanding and agreement that she the said Susan McCoy was to have one half of the said tract of Land conveyed to her which owing to the death of the said J. H. W. McCoy could not be done as to his part all which will more plainly appear by reference to the said bill and proceedings of record in the said Court of Equity, and the cause being at issue before the honorable Court came on to be heard, at June Term after filing the said Bill, when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation on the premises did order, adjudge and decree that the said Commissioner in equity
