E. 25 Chs 75 links to the Beginning containing about seventy acres, Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the premises belonging. To have & to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said James Mays his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant & forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Mays his heirs & assigns against myself, my heirs and assigns and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any parts thereof.
