

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Taylor, his heirs and assigns forever. I bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said Thomas Taylor his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 19<sup>th</sup> Octbr 1843
