

Yelman Smith Deed for 331 Acres of Land.

To William Barnett } State of South Carolina, } Know all men  
Greenville District. } by these presents,

that I, Yelman Smith, of the State and District aforesaid for  
and in consideration of the sum of Ten Hundred Dollars to  
me paid by William Barnett of the same State and dis-  
trict, have given, granted, bargained, sold, released and con-  
veyed and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, re-  
lease and convey unto him the said William Barnett a  
certain tract or parcel of Land situate, lying, and being  
in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid, on both sides  
of Mill Creek, waters of Middle Tyger river, and bounded  
as follows; Beginning on a black oak, thence N. 64° E. 33  
ch. to a post oak thence N. 7 1/2° E. 53 ch. to a post oak -  
thence N. 69° W. 55 ch. to a Chestnut thence S. 40° W. 10 ch.  
50 lks. to a chestnut thence S. 11. 50 lks. to a red oak S.  
5° W. 31 ch. 50 lks. to a Sourwood thence S. 54° W. 3 ch.  
50 lks. to a chestnut thence S. 35° E. 36 ch. 50 lks. to the  
beginning, containing three hundred and thirty-one Acres, be the  
same more or less; To have and to hold the above granted  
premises, together with all and singular the members, privileges,  
and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise incident  
or appertaining; and I the said Yelman Smith do hereby bind  
myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns forever, to  
warrant and defend the above granted premises unto him the  
said William Barnett, his heirs and assigns, against myself  
my heirs, executors, administrators and against any other  
person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any  
part thereof. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and  
affixed my seal this thirtieth day of August in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-two.
