Know all men by these presents, that I, William Cunningham, of the District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Eight Dollars and Fifty Cents to me in hand paid by Yerah W. Green, of the State and District aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Yerah W. Green, all that tract or parcel of land containing more or less than three fourths be the same more or less, situate, lying and being in the State and District aforesaid, on waters of Enoree River, it being a part of that lot of Land originally granted to William Cunningham by John S. Dulon and hath such marks and corners as follows: Beginning on a Spanish Oak 3 x running N. 58 W. 27.25 to a stake thence S. 42 W. E. 27.25 to a black gum, thence N. 43 W. E. 7.17 to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members, appurtenances and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Green his heirs and assigns forever. And I do here by bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Yerah W.
