




ing of the parties to these presents, that if the said John Bryson

 shall be utterly null and void, any thing herein contained to the con-  
 trary thereof in any wise notwithstanding. And it is covenanted and  
 agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents, that until  
 default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid sum, as before  
 set forth, and the interest for the same, it shall and may be law-  
 ful to and for the said John Bryson peaceably and quietly to hold,  
 use, occupy, possess and enjoy all and singular the premises above gran-  
 ted and released, and every part thereof, with the appurtenances, and to have,  
 receive, and take the rents, issues and profits, to his own particular use  
 and behoof, any thing herein contained to the contrary hereof in any wise  
 notwithstanding.

 Mortgage.

This Indenture, made the seventeenth  
 day of July in the year of our Lord one thou-  
 sand eight hundred and forty-four between John A. Leland, Superintend-  
 ent of Public Works of the State aforesaid, of the one part, and Reu-  
 bin Talley, of the other part:

Whereas, The said Reubin Talley stands indebted to the said  
 John A. Leland, Superintendent as aforesaid by Bonds for the sum of  
 Forty One Dollars and three cents payable in three annual instalments,  
 with interest from the date thereof, That is to say, one third part with  
 interest, on the seventeenth day of July, 1845, one other third part with  
 interest, on the seventeenth day of July, 1846, and the remaining third part  
 with interest, on the seventeenth July, 1847.
