 bargained, bargained, sold, and released and by these presents do grant, bar-  
 gain, sell and release unto the said Noah R. Smith a certain tract of land  
 containing One Hundred Acres, situate in said District in the waters of  
 the North fork of Saluda River, and hath such bounds, marks, &c. as fol-  
 lows, viz: Beginning at a Red Oak 3 x on the old Green-Road thence S.  
 6 W. 12 chs. to a P. O. 3 x on the new Greenville Road thence S. 18 W. 36 chs.
