Smith now resides, together with all and singular the rights hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in anywise incident to Rose and to Hold to the only use of the said Armstead King, his heirs, Executors, administrators or assigns forever, and I do hereby warrant and defend the same from myself, my heirs, Executors adm^{rs} &c. and from every person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof given under my hand and seal this the Twentieth day of January Eighteen hundred and thirty-seven & of the Independence of the United States of America the sixty-first year.
