 mentioned, Have this day granted, bargained, sold, aliened, & by these presents
 do grant, bargain, sell & release, unto the S. McClanahan, all that Tract, Piece or
 parcel of Land, in the District of Greenville & State aforesaid, on Waters of Rudy
 River, lying immediately in front of S. G. McClanahan's House of residence, bound-
 ed on one side by S. McClanahan's Land, & otherwise by my own, embracing all
 the Land that lies between the two roads running on each side of S. McClanahan's
 House, supposed to contain five acre more or less, Together with all & singular the
 rights, members, appurtenances, & appurtenances, to the said Premises belonging, or in any
 wise incident or appertaining. To have, & to hold, all & singular, the said Premises, unto
 the said S. G. McClanahan his heirs & assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors & assigns to Warrant & forever
 defend, all & singular, the said Premises, unto the said S. G. McClanahan, his heirs,
 and assigns, against myself & my heirs, & against every other person or persons whomsoever,
 lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal
 the twenty-eighth day of January, eighteen hundred, and forty-five, & in the sixty-
