Curston all that tract of land and plantation situated in Greenville District on Pyles Branch waters of Sandy River containing acreable to a survey made by Samuel Moore. Three hundred and twenty two acres be the same Moore or less Beginning at a small head oak corner just below where the mill stands Running thence S. 36 1/2 E. 16 ch. to a stake corner Thence S. 39 1/2 W. 60.50 ch. to a stump corner: Thence N.
