ed, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said John Cooley Two tracts of Land situate
and lying in the State and District aforesaid Between Mountain Creek
& Saluda River The one beginning on a Post oak 3x and running
thence S. 72 N. 6. 70 to a stake 3x thence N 74 W. 14. 50 to a pine
3x thence S. 75 N. 8. 50 to a Post oak 3x thence S. 35 E. 60 to a
stake 3x thence N. 10 W. 57. to the Beginning. The other Beginning
on a Post oak 3x and running thence S. 35 E. 77 to a Hickory
3x thence S. 69 W. 6. to a Hickory 3x thence N. 37 W. 69. 25 to a
stake 3x thence N. 17 E. 11. 25 to the Beginning Both tracts togeth-
er containing one hundred & twenty-eight acres (more or less) Together
with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appur-
tenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining,
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said John Cooley his heirs and assigns forever. And I do
hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators to war-
rant and forever defend all and singular the premises before men-
tioned unto the said John Cooley his heirs and assigns against my-
self and my heirs, and against every other person whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty
four & in the sixty-eighth year of the Independence of the United
States of America.
