and State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
these presents, bargain sell and release unto the said Levy Newby, a  
tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in District and State  
aforesaid on the land water of Emers River containing sixty acres more  
or less and bounded as follows, beginning as a chertie sapling on the  
Mountain path running South 63 N. E. 50 to a chertie Corner S. 34 N.  
to 50 to a pine stump S. 47 N. E. 80 to a black oak stump S. 64 N. E. 90  
to a dead chertie stump S. 21 E. 21 to a chertie stump on Henry  
Lynch's line to white oak corner on the branch thence a Conditional  
line to the beginning, Together with all and singular the rights, members,  
benefits and appurtenances unto the said Levy Newby and his heirs  
future and do hereby bind myself my heirs execution and administra-  
tors to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto  
the said Levy Newby his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs  
and against every other Person or Persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and affix my seal  
this 24<sup>th</sup> day of August Eighteen hundred and forty four
