



55 to a Red oak Thence N 82 W 14 to a Hickory N 28 W 29.50
to a chestnut Thence N 14 E 60 to a stake thence S 45 E 59 to
the beginning Corner Together with all and singular the rights
members & appurtenances and appertinances to said premises or
in any wise belonging in any wise to have and to hold all

heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
