Bill of Sale for Negro Boy Aaron.

South Carolina, Greenville District. Know all men by these presents that the John & Rebecca Lowell have sold unto Charles Garrison for and consideration of the

sum of five hundred and five dollars to us in hand paid before the delivery of these presents a certain Negro man Aaron, and we the said John & Rebecca Lowell do warrant and defend the Right of said Negro unto the said Charles Garrison against ourselves our heirs or assigns and against all other persons whomsoever. March 5th 1845.
