4 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake on said street near Rudy River, thence S. 32 E.
231 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a hole, made in a rock near the said River, thence N.
17 E. 155 feet to the beginning corner, it being a part of a lot of land
sold and conveyed by Vandy Mcbee to said Cox the 7th day of October
