Foster, all that Tract piece or parcel of Land Situate, lying and being in the District of Greenville South Carolina Situate on both sides of Creek the waters of South Sacolet River containing Three hundred and fifty acres, be the same more or less - Beginning at a Maple 3 x 3 x 0, m, on the East side of said Creek where the Road crosses, Running thence S 70 W. 30 chains to White Oak per D. Oak gone, thence N. 81 W. 41.00 chains to a chestnut 3 x 3 x 0, m, thence N 33 W. 30.00 chains to a Spanish Oak 3 x 3 x 0, m. thence N. 89 E. 21.50 chains to a chestnut 3 x 3 x 0, m, thence N. 79 E. 5.40 chains to a Oak 3 x 0 m,
