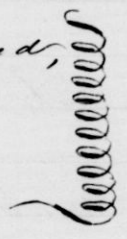

I, David Hoke, Sheriff of Greenville District, and State aforesaid, send

Greeting: Whereas, by virtue of sundry Writs of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the District of Greenville, tested the Eight day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four at the suit of Joseph Six to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements, of Joseph Embury, to levy the sum of Fifty four Dollars ⁵⁶ 100 damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Joseph Embury all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, containing Eight hundred & Sixty acres, situate and being in the District of Greenville adjoining lands of O'Harris Barton, Thomas McChere, William Turner et al. being the same whereon Defendants now live.
