

Ashmore of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said William H. Ashmore a part of a tract of land lying and being in the district and State aforesaid on both sides of Reedy River it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to James M^c Williams by his Excellency Benjⁿ: Gerard on the 24th day of January 1785 the land to be conveyed beginning on the north side of Reedy River at the mouth of George Spillers spring branch on his line to Owens line thence on Owens line to Rodgers line thence on Rodgers line to the River thence up the river to Lunderminds line thence along Jacob Lunderminds line to Henry Lunderminds line thence on Henry Lunderminds line to John Lunderminds line thence on John Lunderminds line to the branch and from the branch a long the fence to the gate on the road thence up the road to Eli Pollards corner thence on sd Pollards line to Dennis corner thence on Dennis line to in river thence up the river to the beginning including one hundred and ninety eight acres by ¹⁰referring to a plat made by J.
