Ashmore his executors administrators and assigns shall or lawfully may have hold and enjoy the said every part and parcel thereof and dispose of thereof and convey the same to his and this own proper use and behoof as he or they shall think fit Witness my hand and seal this the 21st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven and in sixty second year of the Independence of United States of America.

said a part of a tract or Parcel of Land, Lying on Barber's
Creek, waters of Enoree, beginning at a White Oak near the Branch,
from thence West to a Red Oak corner on the old Indian Bound-
