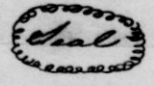

and affection which I have and bear unto my adopted nephew William Poor of Anderson Dist and also of Divers other good Causes and Considerations me the said Sarah Avery have given granted and confirmed and by these presents do give grant and Confirm unto the said William Poor a molatter girl or slave for life about two years and six months old and bears the name of Mary Jane to have hold and enjoy for the only proper use of the said William Poor his heirs and assigns forever and I the said Sarah Avery have put the said William Poor in full possession by delivering to him the said Molatter Girl at the time of the assignment of this instrument and in the presence of these witnesses. Given under my hand seal 27 October 1846.
