 unto the said James W. Dickson a certain Tract or parcel of Land  
 (it being two thirds of the tract whereon Henry Cannon late of Green-  
 ville District resided) which was bequashed to us by his last will  
 and testament & divided from the other third by John Weaver Esq<sup>r</sup>.
