I know all men by these presents. That I William Durham in Consideration of the sum of Sixty nine Dollars and twenty Cents. to me in hand paid by B. Durham and R. Loveland all of the State and District aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said B. Durham and R. Loveland all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on both sides of Jamison's Mill Creek waters of South Carolina. Beginning on a white oak on the north bank of sd Creek running N 48 W. 33 chs. to a Red Oak, Thence N 35 W. 13 ch. to a Red Oak, Thence S 5 W. 30 ch 50 L. to a stake on James Cochran's back line, Thence S. 15 E. 4 ch. 50 L. to a large Chestnut Thence at W. E. course to a small Red Oak on James Cochran's old line thence along sd line S. 75 E. to a small Gum a conditional corner on Lentys old line, Thence along sd line to Caswell Parrett's corner on a Red oak, Thence along S. Parrett's line to the beginning, Containing one hundred acres more or less Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold, all and singular the Premises before mentioned, unto the said B. Durham and R. Loveland their Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and lawfully defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said B. Durham and R. Loveland their Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
