Beginning at a Red Oak 3x on the old Spartanburgh road, Thence S. 29° E. 16.25' to a White oak 3x at the head of a Branch, Thence down said Branch 10 ch. To a Stake 3x Thence N. 45° E. 2.25' to a Hickory 3x. Thence S. 30° E. 16.50' to a Stake, on the original line of said line.
