by these presents that I Gibson Southern of
of the District and State aforesaid for an in consideration of the sum Four Hundred
Dollars to me in hand paid by Miles Southern of the District and State aforesaid
have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Miles Southern a certain Tract of Land containing
One Hundred Acres be the same more or less. Situated lying and being in the
District and State aforesaid on the West side of Enore River it being part of a
Tract of Land bequeathed to me by my father Gibson Southern Sr

With a Conditional line as follows Viz.

Beginning at a point straight across the River to a Rock corner. Together with all
and singular the rights members hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident, or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
the said premises unto the said Miles Southern his heirs and assigns for ever, and I
do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators, to warrant and ever
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Miles Southern his heirs
and assigns, and against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand
I have hereunto set my hand and seal the Tenth day of January in the year of
our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Forty Three
