 did seize and possess consisting of First the Home Tract supposed to con-
 tain about one Hundred and twenty five acres Second the Fox Branch tract
 containing Three Hundred and thirty five acres more or less Third the
 Packette Tract containing Three Hundred and sixty acres more or less
 and they did at the time of the Execution of the said deed of Attorney and
 still do freely voluntarily and without any compulsion dread or fear of
 any person or persons whomsoever renounce, release and forever relinquish to
 all their Estate interest and inheritance in the said Tracts of Land unto the
 Grantor or Grantors of the said Shantou Pool, by Virtue of said deed of Attorney

 and West by lands belonging to H. G. Johnson on the East by lands belonging to J. C.
 Sullivan on the North by lands belonging to Nancy Sims and Jonathan Devereux The other
 Tract containing Sixty Acres more or less Situated in the State and District aforesaid bounded
 on the South by lands belonging to H. G. Johnson on the East by lands belonging to J. C. Sul-
 livan on the North by lands belonging to J. C. Sullivan Together with all and singular
 the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said
 J. R. Smith his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
