persons above named and Blackman J Sizer and Nancy Sizer his wife  
and I do truly warrant this sale and release by me made in behalf of the parties  
of said good and effectual to convey their interest in said negroes except as to the  
said Blackman J Sizer and wife for whom no contract is undertaken
