

void and of none effect any thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding And it is hereby Declared by and between the said parties and the said James A Harrison his executors Administrators and assigns doth covenant promise and agree to and with the Joseph W Whittier his heirs executors administrators and assigns of these Presents that if default should happen to be made of a payment of the said sum of money Six hundred and twenty nine dollars 88^{cts} as aforesaid according to the true intent and meaning of the notes and seal that then and in such case it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Joseph W Whittier his executors administrators attorneys or agents from time to time and at all times hereafter peaceably and quietly to enter into any or all the messuages lands or tenements of the said James A Harrison and to take the said Negro Slaves in his custody and possession and the same to hold and detain to his use and behoof "as his own proper goods and chattels" for term of years or the same to sell and dispose of at will and pleasure returning the surplus of any should happen to be after paying the said sum of Six hundred and twenty Nine dollars 88^{cts} and interest unto the said James A Harrison his executors administrators and assigns.
