The rights hereditaments and appurtenances belonging and in any wise whatsoever appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said lands and premises unto the said Emily Christopher her heirs assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the lands and premises before mentioned unto the said Emily Christopher her heirs and assigns forever and against my self my heirs and against all and every persons or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
